Approval of Minutes

Regular Session Minutes February 10, 2012

a. Initial Review of New Complaints

After reviewing the complaint and hearing from Ms. Gootzeit, Christine Feltman Rosenberg moved for dismissal. Rebecca Grabski seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0

b. Open Complaints/Investigations

Kerry Deering 11-OT-0104, The Board heard testimony from several former techs of Deering Therapy. Most expressed apprehension about testifying. They were afraid of the possible repercussions because Kingman is a small town. The discussions centered on the billing practices, treatment of patients and unprofessionalism on the part of Kerry Deering

The Board also heard testimony from several current employees in support of Mr. Deering. These discussions centered on Mr. Deering's excellent patient care and the family type atmosphere at Deering Therapy.

After hearing the testimonies, the Board directed staff to do some more investigating and provide the Board their findings at the next Board meeting.
