a. Initial Review of New Complaints

- 1. Dr. Ehren Doty, Body Mechanics Physical Therapy, after some discussion the Board decided that it had no jurisdiction to hear the complaint. John Tutelman moved to dismiss the complaint. Rebecca Grabski seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0
- 2. Susan Stockdale, Southwest Therapy Specialists, after some discussion the Board decided that it had no jurisdiction to hear the complaint. Laura Beckman moved to dismiss the complaint. Christine Feltman Rosenberg seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.
- 3. Linda Hull 11-OT-2216, after some discussion the Board determined that Ms. Hull had not violated any Board statute or rule. Christine Feltman Rosenberg moved to dismiss the complaint. Laura Beckman seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0

b. Open Complaints/Investigations

- 1. Dena Hargis, 11-OT-1999, John Tutelman, Vice Chair presided and called on the complainants, Robert and Lisa Herrmann to address the Board. The Herrmanns explained that the reason for their complaint was the unprofessionalism of Dena Hargis. The Herrmanns provided various documents to prove their case. Mr. Tutelman then called for Dena Hargis to address the Board. Ms. Hargis appeared before the Board and answered numerous questions regarding the complaint. At the conclusion of the questioning, the Board discussed the options they had based on the testimony heard. John Tutelman moved to open a complaint and set the case for an informal hearing. Laura Beckman seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0. Rebecca Grabski recused herself.
- 2. Donna Montgomery, 11-OT-2812, The Board resumed reviewing this case tabled from the September 16, 2011. Various witnesses addressed the Board regarding Ms. Montgomery. The Board heard from the complainant, Mr. Eric Amiel, who was represented by Attorney Beverly Wittekind. Mr. Amiel provided various documents for the Board to review. Ms. Montgomery appeared before the Board and spoke on her behalf. Ms. Montgomery stated that the allegations made against her were incorrect. She stated that the times and number of people she saw was inaccurate. After much discussion with both parties, Rebecca Grabski moved to offer a consent agreement for probation to Ms. Montgomery. Laura Beckman seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.
